RESOLUTION TO APPOINT A RECEIVING BOARD FOR ELECTIONS

Board member White, supported by board member Loveing, both serving as members of the Bertrand Charter Township Election Commission, moved the adoption of the following:

WHEREAS, the Bertrand Charter Township Clerk is responsible for conducting elections in Bertrand Charter Township; and

WHEREAS, on August 15, 2012, Act 271 of the Public Acts of 2012 took immediate effect and among the election law changes that resulted from PA 271, cities, township and villages are now required to appoint a receiving board; and

WHEREAS, the legislative body of the city, township or village is no longer responsible for appointing the receiving board as that duty has now been transferred to the municipalities election commission; and

WHEREAS, Michigan Election Law (Act 116 of 1954) section MCL 168.679A permits the Bertrand Charter Township Election Commission by resolution to provide for a Receiving Board appointed by the Election Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Bertrand Township Election Day Receiving Board is responsible for the duties as outlined in Section 168.679a of the Michigan Election Law;

WHEREAS, upon adoption of this resolution the compensation set to pay receiving board members will be at a rate of \$15.50 per hour with a minimum payment of one hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Bertrand Charter Township Clerk is authorized to establish an Election Day Receiving Board for elections held in Bertrand Charter Township beginning with the August 8, 2023 Special election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Receiving Board consisting of two or more election inspectors, with an equal number from each major political party will be appointed by the Bertrand Charter Township Election Commission per the recommendation of the Clerk.


